• **Half Day City Tour + San Telmo**

On this tour you will discover the beauty and the origins of Buenos Aires.

We will leave from the La Rural, along the Avenida del Libertador you can appreciate the beauty of the architecture of Buenos Aires. Avenida Alvear, where they are distinguished International class shopping.

Crossing one of the widest avenues in the world, 9 de Julio observe the symbolic Obelisco.

We visit the Plaza de Mayo: Epicenter historical, political and foundation. The Metropolitan Cathedral, Government House, the Cabildo and the Municipality.

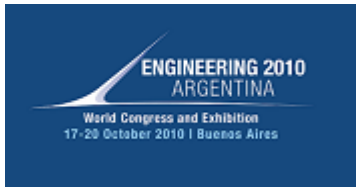

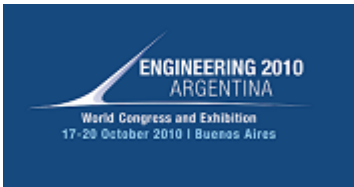

Pass by the Avenida Alvear, where they are distinguished class shopping.

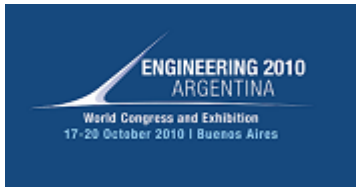

Discover the story of Evita to understand the contemporary history of Argentina. The history of Peronism in Argentina has left its mark on the buildings, squares and neighborhoods of Buenos Aires. The excursion identified milestones related to this political movement, with emphasis on the life and work of Eva Perón, one of its greatest exponents.

Other points that stand out are his life, his political activity, his tragic death and birth of all the myths that his life and death have inspired. The museum, located in the house that the Eva Perón Foundation acquired it in 1958, exhibits paintings, advertising, clothing and a video abduction of the body of Eva Perón.

We will pick you up through the hotel and embark on the journey towards Recoleta and Palermo, visiting the Basilica Our Lady of Pilar (serving drinks and alfajores).

Visit the Evita Museum, where we have lunch (3 steps to choice, with water, soda, glass of wine and coffee), and typical empanadas and Argentinian picada.
